Earlier this month, our Year 1 pupils took their phonics test. This is a national screening test designed to assess pupils' ability to decode and is a necessary first step in acquiring the key skill of reading. I am delighted to be able to inform you that 100% of our pupils passed the test this year and I would like to congratulate all of our Year 1 pupils and the teaching staff on their achievement.

The final placing of the Hurricane Hawks Racing Team was also announced this week with the boys being awarded 7<sup>th</sup> place overall. This is a very impressive ranking given that 36 teams from all over the country entered the event and once again, I would like to congratulate the team and their support staff.


