Year 3 had a brilliant time at Farmwise! Thank you to Mr Adams for helping on the trip.






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## CLASS 2

This week as part of our English work on The Dragon Machine, we thought about verbs that dragons might do. Here are the pictures of us pouncing, climbing, roaring and even fighting!


