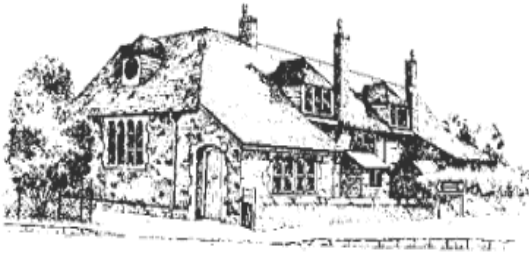

Year 3 had a wonderful time at Blundell's Spring Garden event on Thursday. They enjoyed planting sunflower, cornflower and cosmos seeds.

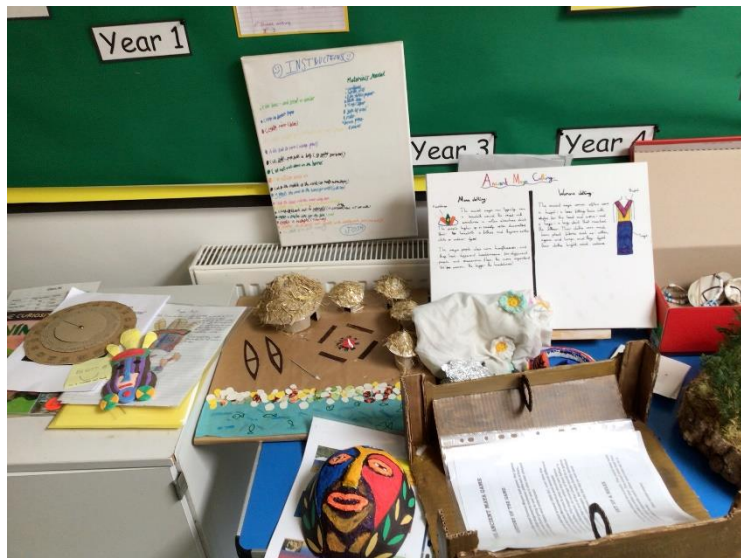
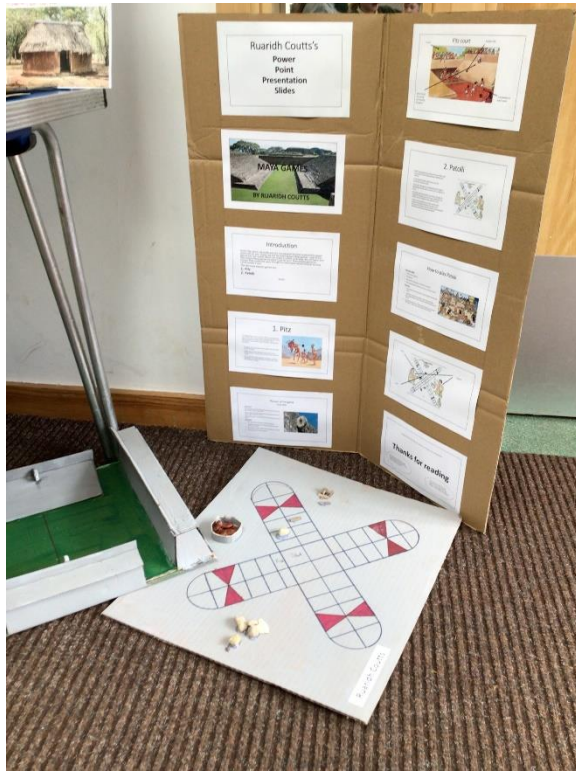
