- Practicing pencil control using a variety of pencils and pens.

EYFS and Year One Personal, Social, Spiritual and Emotional Development.

Selecting and using activities.
Can play in a group, extending and elaborating ideas.
More outgoing to unfamiliar people
More confident in new situations
Aware of own feelings and knows that some actions and words can hurt other people's feelings.

Listening to others in small groups and being able to follow directions.

EYFS Mathematics Numbers and shape, space and measure:
Use number names
Says numbers in order to 10
Knows that numbers identify how many objects are in a set
Compares two groups of objects saying when they have the same number
Shows and interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects

Counts in 2's, 5's and 10's
Write numbers to 100
Order numbers

Gives meanings to marks they draw and paint
Uses some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning
Writes own name
Phonic activities

Year One Literacy

Looking at information texts
Labels lists and captions
Senses poetry

Possible Activities

- Facts about them, who am I?
- Writing about their families
- Label parts of body
- Using senses to write poems
- Daily Phonics sessions

Year one

- Spell by segmenting into phonemes
- Learn to spell common 'exception' words
- Using appropriate size letters and spacing

Shows interest in the lives of people who are familiar to them
Knows some of the things that make them unique
Comments and asks questions about aspect of their familiar world, where they live
Develop an understanding of growth and changes over time
