Throughout July, our children will be taking part in transition days where they will spend time with their new classes or schools and we will also be welcoming the children and their families who are due to join us in September.

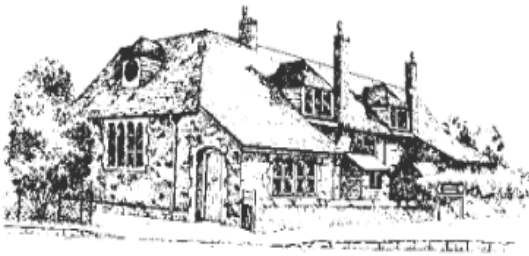
