On Friday 5th April there will be no after school club as it is the end of term.

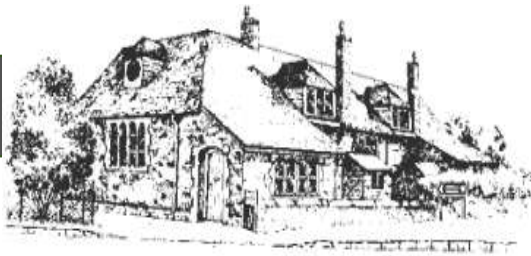
FRONT ENTRANCE
