Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be able to inform you that a number of our pupils have been successful in this year's Young Writers Ancient Adventures competition and their work has been chosen for publication in Ancient Adventures 2019 - Devon. I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Phoebe B, Freya, Beau, Dorothy, Coen, Harry B, Elliot, Edward, Jodie, Healey, Poppy, Briony, Winnie and Max on their fantastic achievement and can't wait to read their stories when the book is published.

You may be aware from recent media reports that school across the country are taking part in EYFS baseline pilot tests. Bolham Primary School has been asked to take part in this pilot and our EYFS children have been selected to take part in some simple baseline assessment. As a school, we have always assessed children upon entry as part of our assessment for learning and next steps and as part of our usual practice the children will have the opportunity to sit individually with Mrs Worthington to do some activities involving counting or talking about a picture. Please be assured that children will not be required to sit any formal tests involving a test paper under timed circumstances. If you wish to discuss any aspect of our assessment process with your child's teacher, please do not hesitate to contact the school. Due to the confidential aspect of the pilot however we are unable to share assessment materials with you.

Next week, Mrs Worthington and Mrs Hillier are offering parents of pupils in their classes to come along and learn more about the way in which we teach phonics, the Year 1 phonics assessment and the expectations in reading, writing and mathematics at the end of Year 2. The meeting will be taking place in Class 2 and a crèche will be available in Class 1 for the children.

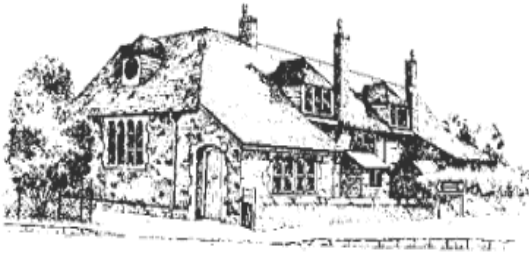
Finally, is your child in Class 1 or Class 2, or entitled to free school meals in Classes 3 and 4? If so, please can you help by ensuring that your child has a school dinner on Thursday, 3rd October. This is the day when the School Census is taken and if all of our children have the meals they are entitled to, the school will be given the money required to offer free school meals to all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils and those pupils entitled to free school meals in Key Stage 2. If children do not take up their provision on Thursday, 3rd October, but have meals throughout the rest of the year, the cost has to come from the school's general budget which means there is less money to spend on teaching and learning. You will be aware I am sure of increasing financial pressures on schools and at Bolham Primary School we would like to spend all of our money on the children's education. If you feel that you can help us in achieving this and your child is in Class 1 or 2 or entitled to free school meals in Class 3 or 4 please encourage them to take up their school meal **this Thursday** and help us to help your children.

FRONT DOOR

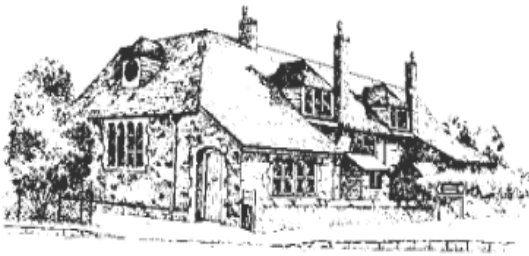
Please can we request that unless you need to speak to a member of staff in the office in the mornings that you do not come in via the front door. Many thanks.
