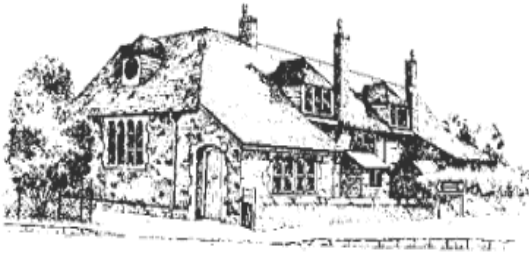
TAG RUGBY

On Thursday 5th March it will be World Book Day again. This year we are inviting children to dress up as their favourite book character, but please do not feel you need to buy an outfit for this event.

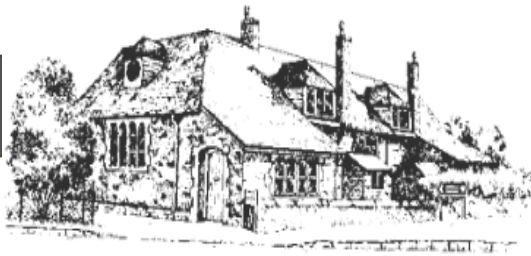
Also, we will be organising time on the day for older children to share books with younger children in the school.

Nellie Alves - Super writing 'Again!' Brilliant - well done.

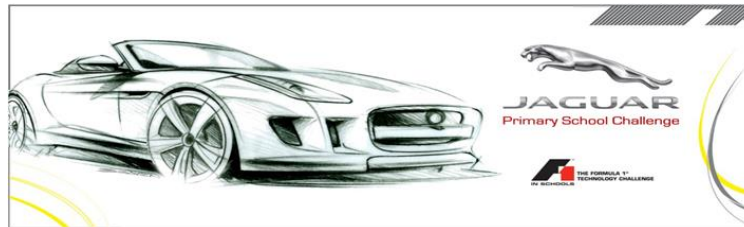
