Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you that as a result of staff and pupil absence we will be operating three classes as from tomorrow. Our Year 4 pupils will be joining Class 4 and will be taught by Ms Brierley and 8 of our Year 2 pupils will be joining Class 3 and Mr Botham. Please note that if you have a child in Class 2 we will contact you directly if we are asking them to join Class 3. If you **do not** hear from us, please can they line up with Class 2 as normal in the morning.

I have been made aware that some parents have concerns about the continued provision of school meals. Devon Norse, our school meals contractor has informed us that they will continue to provide meals at the school for as long as possible, but may be unable to provide the advertised menu. In the event of school closure, arrangements have been made for those children whose parents claim a free school meal.

Thank you to everyone who has been contacting the school and keeping us up to date with what is happening to them and their families. As I stated yesterday, the school will provide learning packs for the children in the event of school closure. We are unable however to meet individual requests for learning at the moment for children at home, as our teachers are continuing to work with the children who are in school and we do not have the capacity to meet requests. Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience that this may cause.
