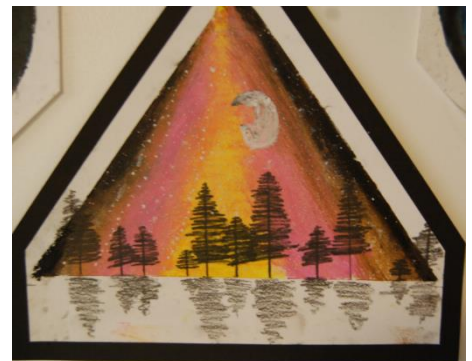

LOST PROPERTY

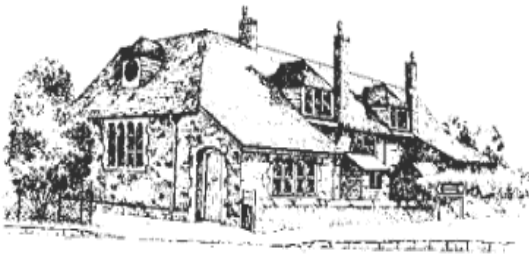
Oliver in Class 3 has lost 2 school jumpers which are clearly named. If you find them please can you return them to Class 3. Many thanks.
