

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES AND FOOD PROGRAMME

Devon County Council is working with local providers to coordinate a programme of free activities and healthy meals for the school holidays for children and young people.

The aim of the scheme is to support children to eat more healthily, be more active over the school holidays and have a greater knowledge of health and nutrition as well as be more engaged with school and other local services.

The children who take part will enjoy fun and enriching activities in a safe and sociable environment and have the opportunity to develop new skills or knowledge and try out new experiences. This could include physical activities such as football, table tennis or cricket; creative activities, for example, putting on a play, junk modelling or drumming workshops or other experiences like a nature walk or visiting a farm.

At least one meal per day will be included and the children will improve their knowledge and awareness of healthy eating.

The scheme aims to help families develop their understanding of nutrition and food budgeting.

Who can access the scheme?

The scheme is available to all children aged 0 to 18 years old who:

- receive benefits related Free School Meals
- have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- have an Education, Health and Care Plan
- have an Early Help Plan
- is a Child in Need

- is a looked after child
- is excluded from education
- is a young carer
- is living on low income due to the COVID-19 pandemic (but isn't in receipt of benefits)
- has a member of their family with mental ill health.

They can also bring a friend who does not need to meet any of the eligibility criteria.

Please note that not all activity providers will be able to accommodate all children and young people aged 0 to 18 years old. Activity providers will specify what age group is appropriate to their activity.
