Dear Parents and Carers,

We were delighted last week to welcome Mrs Rowe as our new music teacher and once again able to offer our full music curriculum. As part of our ongoing music provision we have always offered pupils the opportunity to take part in private individual and group instrumental lessons with visiting teachers. I am delighted this week to inform you that Miss Lewis is now ready to offer this provision once again in school. Miss Lewis has over 20 years experience teaching woodwind at all levels and also teaches string lessons for beginners to grade 2.

Individual lessons with Miss Lewis will take place on Friday afternoons in school and cost £8 for 20 minutes and £12 for 30 minutes.

Miss Lewis offers teaching for the following instruments:

Recorder years 2-6
Flute years 4-6
Clarinet years 4-6
Saxophone years 5-6

Ukulele years 2-6
Violin years 2-6

Online lessons are also available for children and adults at all sorts of days and times. For Bolham school children the online fees are as above. For adults it is £14 per 30 mins online. For adults, weekly lessons are encouraged but fortnightly or occasional lessons also available.



CLASS 3 (C)


Special mention to Hannah Slade for offering to teach Eloise how to skip and to Eloise for perseverance when practising it!
