Dear Parents and Carers,

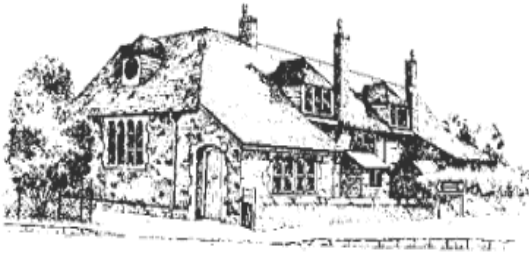

CLASS 2

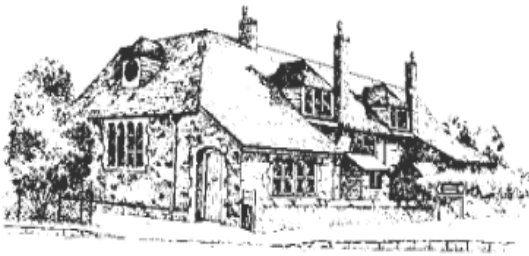
Special mention to all of the Year 2's who have worked so hard on their assessments. You have shown great determination and perseverance.
