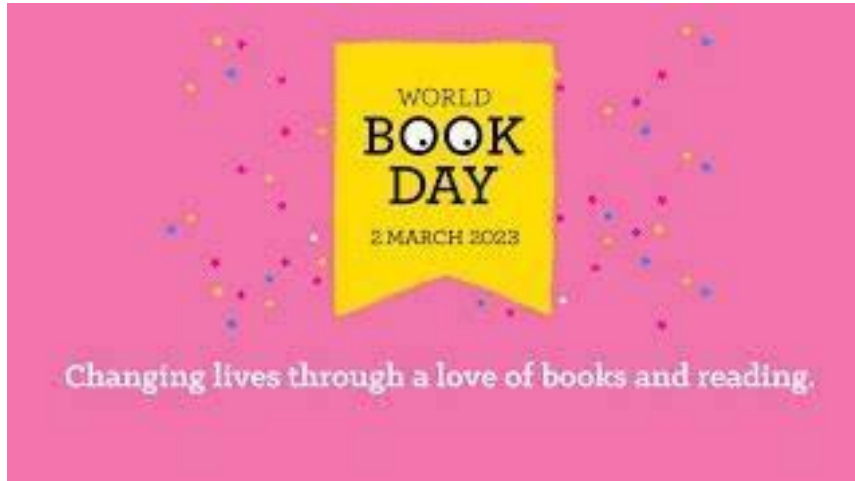
Please note until further notice the meat in the Week 1 roast on a Wednesday will be gammon, not turkey.
